“Corpomaterialidades del dolor. Análisis de experiencias de mujeres con fibromialgia”. The PhD has been supervised by Dr. Rosa Medina Domenech, who has collected the award for her. Dresda’s PhD has been published by Kaótica Libros under the title of “Estados mórbidos. Desgaste corporal en la vida contemporánea” (2022).

Dresda has obtained a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Concordia, where she is currently carrying out her research in the Department of Communication Studies and “working to understand ableism as a system of oppression that affects not only people with or without disabilities, but also as a system that has to do with the way we think and establish relationship with other-than-human lives”
