





ADDENDA TO THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE GRANTING OF A DOUBLE MASTER'S DEGREE (SECOND CYCLE DEGREE) IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES

- This addenda partially modifies the COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE GRANTING OF A DOUBLE MASTER'S DEGREE IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES signed by the rectors of the GEMMA partners institutions in 2017.
- It formalises the inclusion of the University of York (United Kingdom) as full partner institution in the GEMMA Consortium after the official confirmation received from the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) on March 26th 2018 amending the 2017 -1847 / 001-001 Grant Agreement(AMENDMENT n° 2017-1847 /001-002).
- 3. The University of York joins the GEMMA Consortium on the following terms:
- 3.1.The University of York accepts the rights and obligations stipulated in the above-mentioned Cooperation Agreement and all its Annexes (Study Programme, Correspondence table with mobility from/to Bologna and Financial Annex).
- 3.2. This collaboration will officially start from the 2018/2019 academic year.


