





ADDENDA TO THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE GRANTING OF A DOUBLE MASTER'S DEGREE (SECOND CYCLE DEGREE) IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES

- 1. This addenda partially modifies the COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE GRANTING OF A DOUBLE MASTER'S DEGREE IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES signed by the rectors of the GEMMA partners institutions in 2020, amended by the Addenda subscribed in 2021 for the upgrading of CEU-GMBH from Associate Partner to Full partner of the GEMMA Consortium, and by the Addenda subscribed in 2024 for the extension of the validity of the Agreement for one more edition (18th edition, 2024-2026).
- 2. It formalizes the agreement of the Parties to modify the Article 12 "Duration of the Agreement" in order to extend the validity of this Cooperation Agreement for one extra edition (19th edition 2025-2027).
- 3. The modification of the duration of the GEMMA Cooperation Agreement will be done on the following terms:
 - 3.1. Subject to clause 3.3 below, the Agreement will be valid until the end of 2026-2027 academic year. Thus, the new cohort will enrol for the first year of the programme in 2025-2026 and for the second year of the programme in 2026-2027. The provisions of the Agreement concerning the commitments resulting from the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master funding will not be valid anymore due to the conclusion of the financing (last funded GEMMA edition being the one started in a.y. 2023/24).
 - 3.2. Erasmus Mundus scholarships will not be offered in the new edition. Therefore, the students selected under this new cohort covered by the present addenda will participate in the GEMMA programme on a self-financed basis. The distribution of their participation costs will be carried out according to the rules included in the Financial Annex to this Cooperation Agreement.
 - 3.3. In February 2024, the University of York notified the GEMMA partners institutions of its intention to withdraw from the GEMMA Consortium once the current Agreement comes to an end such that it will not accept any new students to the GEMMA programme at the University of York after the 2023-24 GEMMA edition. As a current consortium partner in the GEMMA programme the University of York signs this addendum in order not to interfere in the legal process ruling the cooperation of the GEMMA consortium, although the University of York will not participate in this 19th edition (2025 2027) as full partner and will not be offered as either Home or Mobility institution in the corresponding selection process for such edition.

This addenda is written, undersigned and sealed in eight identical originals in English, all of which are to be given equal legal consideration.
